<b>Personal Data Controller</b>	The controller of your personal data is TESTARMY GROUP SPÓŁKA AKCYJNA with its registered office at ul. Petuniowa 9/5, 53-238 Wrocław (hereinafter: PDC).

<b>Purposes of processing and legal basis for processing personal data</b>	Your personal data will be processed for the following purposes: a. preparation and execution of the contract (Civil Code, concluded contract, Article 6(1)(b) GDPR), b. performance of PDC's legal obligations in terms of accounting and tax regulations (Accounting Act, Corporate Tax Act, Personal Income Tax Act, Value Added Tax Act, Article 6(1)(c) GDPR), c. pursuit of PDC's legitimate interest in the possible establishment or assertion of claims or defense against claims (Civil Code, Article 6(1)(f) GDPR).
<b>Period for which personal data will be processed</b>	Your personal data will be processed for the period of: a. preparation and execution of the contract for the duration of the contract and post-contract settlements, b. performance of PDC's legal obligations in terms of accounting and tax regulations – up to 5 years, c. pursuit of PDC's legitimate interest consisting in the possible establishment or assertion of claims or defense against claims – up to 3 years from the end of the service, and in the case of pending proceedings: for the duration of the proceedings until their final legal conclusion and until the statute of limitations on claims.
<b>Recipients of personal data</b>	The recipients of your personal data are: a. board members, b. video service application providers, c. web application providers, d. internet mail providers, e. banking service providers, f. accounting service providers, g. postal service providers, h. legal service providers, i. server service providers, j. tax settlement authorities.
<b>Rights of the data subject</b>	You have the right to: a. access your data (including receiving a copy of your personal data), b. rectify (amend) your personal data, c. restrict the processing of your personal data, d. object to the processing of your personal data, e. portability of your personal data.  If you become aware of unlawful processing of your personal data, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, which is the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, based in Warsaw, at ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw.  In order to prevent a violation of your rights or freedoms caused by a breach of personal data security, please be informed that we will not exercise any of your rights under Articles 15-21 GDPR through a phone call.
<b>Information about the requirement to provide personal data</b>	The provision of your personal data is a prerequisite for the conclusion and execution of the contract, in accordance with the provisions of generally applicable law. The consequence of failure to provide personal data required by law is inability to conclude and perform the contract.
